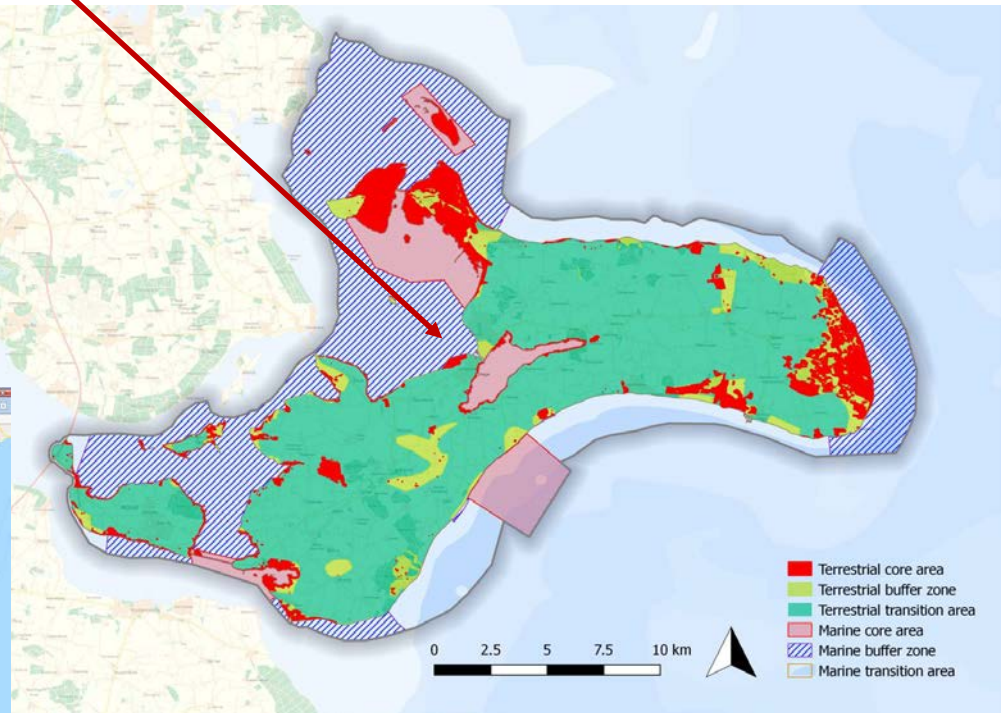
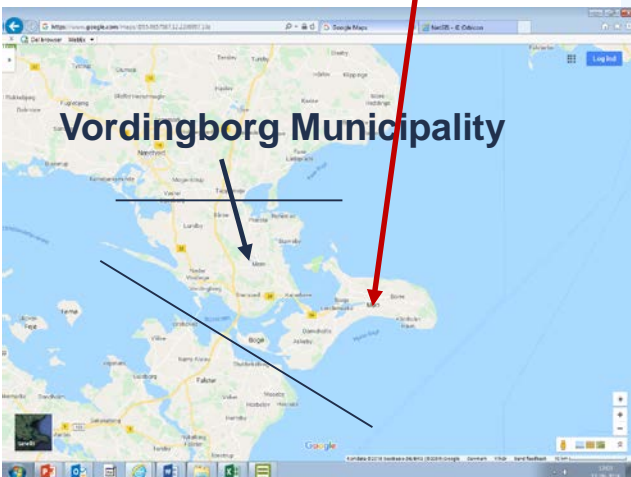
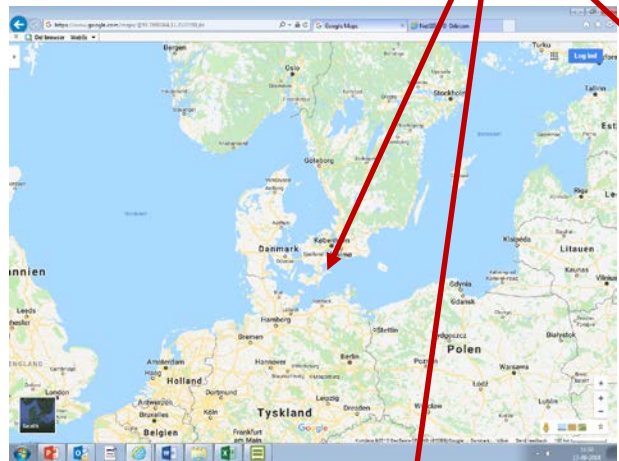

- Vordingborg Municipality: Population 47.000
- Møn (the biosphere reserve): Population 9 – 10.000.

Main occupation: Tourism, farming, trade, small industrial plants, industrial fishing.

 - Learning: Networking, clusters
 - Development: Sustainable tourism, local products

Fishing Zealand:

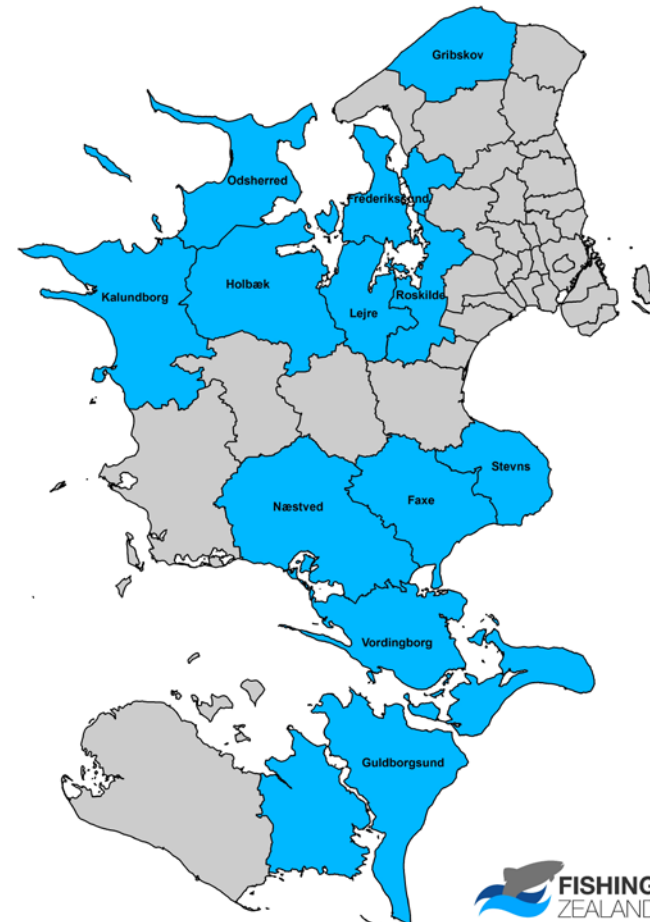
